- _____ Complete ONE of the General Education patterns: Saddleback College GE, California State University GE (CSUGE) or the Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC). **NOTE: Associate Degree for Transfer (AA-T/AS-T) require completion of CSUGE or IGETC.**
- _____ Complete major requirements as listed in the College Catalog. A "C" (or "P" Pass) or better for major courses is required.
- _____ Have 12 units in residency at Saddleback College.
- _____ Complete Math and Reading Competency.
- _____ Complete a minimum of 60 degree applicable units with an overall 2.0 grade point average in all units attempted.

MATH COMPETENCY – Complete Option A or Option B

Option A: Completion with a grade of "C" or better in one of the following courses: MATH 2, 3A or 3AH, 3B, 3C, 7, 8, 10, 11, 14, 24, 26, 30A/CS 30A, 30B/CS 30B, 103, 124, 205, 253; PSYC 44

Option B: Evidence of one of the following:

1. A score of 3 or above on the College Board Advanced Placement Exam
2. 530 or above on the Mathematics section of the SAT
3. 23 or above on the ACT Mathematics Test
4. 520 or above on the College Board Math Achievement Test

READING COMPETENCY – Complete Option A or Option B

Option A: Completion, with a grade of "C" or better: ENG 1A or 1AH, 1B or 1BH, 70, 180, 190, 340^.

^Units earned for ENG 340 do not apply to the associate degree.

Option B: Evidence of one of the following standardized examination scores:

1. A score of 30-37 on the CTEP Reading Challenge
2. 400 or above on the Critical Reading section of the SAT
3. 19 or above on the ACT English Test
